

Angling Rules

- a) All participants must hold proper California and/or Mexican fishing licenses and comply with all relevant rules and regulations. No tournament boundaries apply. Eligible species are halibut, tuna (albacore, bluefin, or yellowfin), yellowtail, and white seabass.
- b) Sporting tackle only – circle hooks preferred.
- c) Only one fish per species per angler may be submitted.
- d) All fish brought to the dock must be weighed at a landing or other certified scale. Each angler is responsible for filling out and submitting his/her score sheet (available in Event Program or for download from the official HSWRI website). For catches, all score sheets must be signed by the angler and weighmaster and submitted by 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 31.

Broodstock catch records will be kept separately by HSWRI collection team.

- e) Winners will be determined by weight. Any ties will be decided by a coin flip.

Angling Awards

Anglers may submit one fish per eligible species (see above). The heaviest single fish will determine the winner in Categories A through E (ties will be decided by a coin flip). The heaviest combined weight (one fish from each eligible species) will decide the winner in Category F.

- C. High Kayak Angler
- D. High Spearfishing Angler
- E. High Junior Angler
- F. High Tournament Angler
