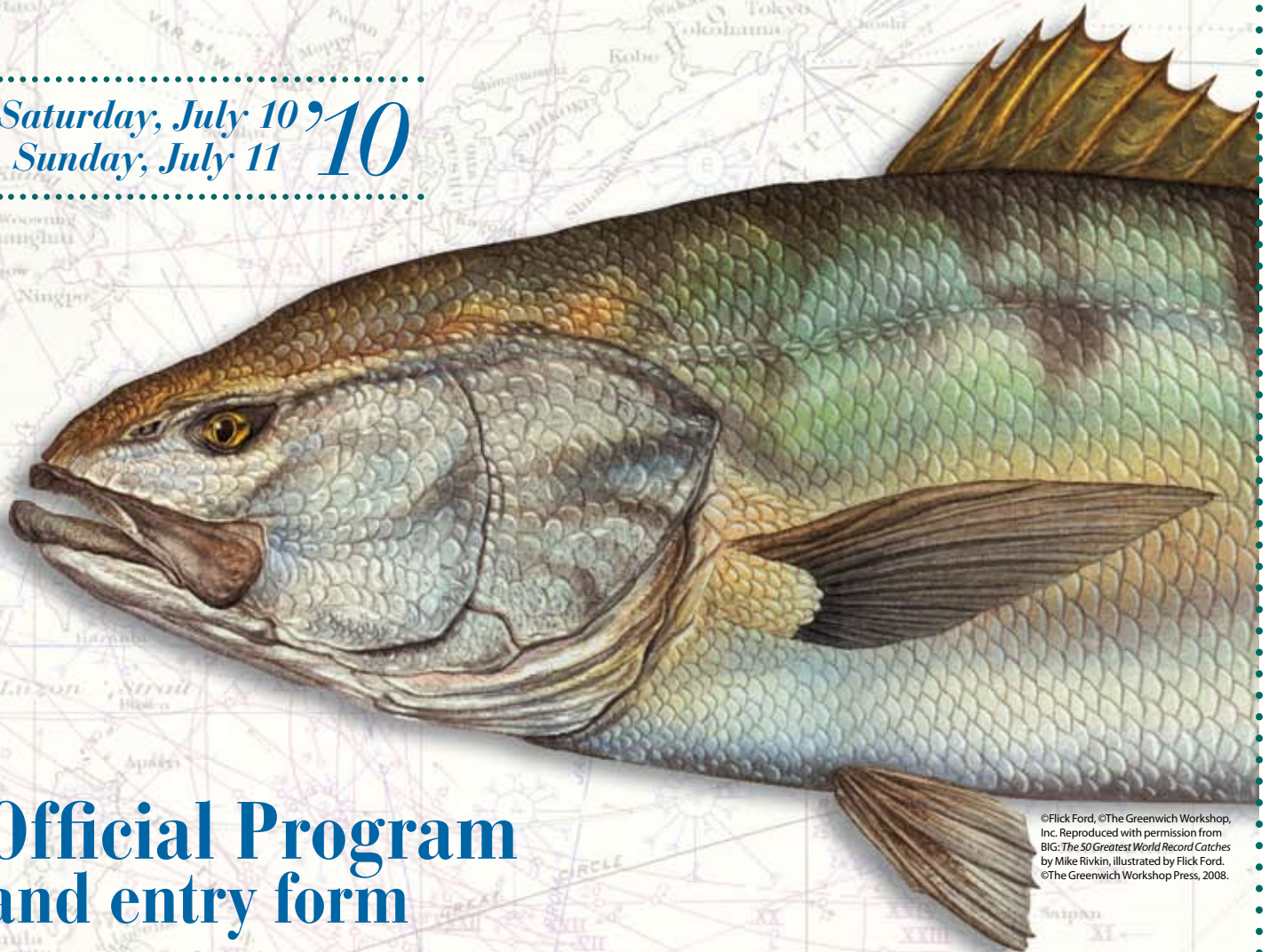

This event is designed to kick off the 2010 angling season with a combination of friendly competition and good clean fun. We also hope that it becomes a major source of exposure and support for Hubbs-SeaWorld Research Institute (HSWRI), one of the world's leading centers of critical marine research.

You may not know it, but HSWRI has been adding to California's white seabass populations for more than 20 years. Our program of broodstock collection, optimized spawning, and distribution of seabass fingerlings to more than 13 grow-out locations throughout southern California has been underway since 1983. More than 1.6 million juvenile white seabass have been tagged and released during this period. We are the world leaders in the field of white seabass stock replenishment, and we share your delight in of the recovery of this exciting species over the past two decades. It wasn't all because of us, but we certainly did our part.



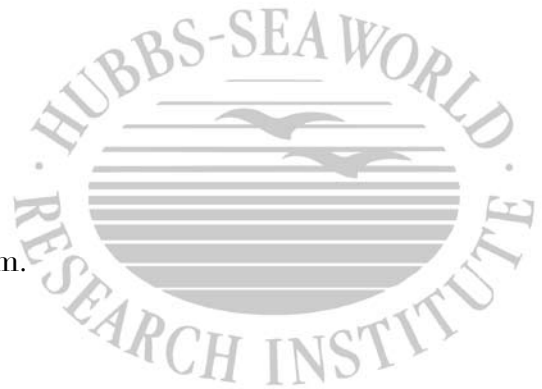

# Angling Rules

- a) All participants must hold proper California and/or Mexican fishing licenses and comply with all relevant rules and regulations. No tournament boundaries apply. Eligible species are halibut, tuna (albacore, bluefin, or yellowfin), yellowtail, and white seabass.
- b) Sporting tackle only — circle hooks preferred. All IGFA angling rules apply (*visit [www.igfa.org](http://www.igfa.org) for more details*).
- c) Only one fish per species per angler may be submitted.
- d) All fish brought to the dock must be weighed at a landing or other certified scale. Each angler is responsible for filling out and submitting their score sheet found elsewhere in this program or downloaded from the official HSWRI website. All released fish must be similarly documented. Completed score sheets must be faxed to tournament control by 11:59 pm on Saturday (*see score sheet for details*)
- e) Winners will be determined by weight. Any ties will be decided by a coin flip.
- f) Official Weigh Stations

*Note:* During the tournament, HSWRI scientists will be at sea off San Diego waters to collect live white seabass for broodstock. Any and all white seabass of legal size and in good condition would be hugely appreciated. Collection procedures will be reviewed at Thursday's captain's meeting. All anglers who successfully catch and hold for collection will receive a special award.

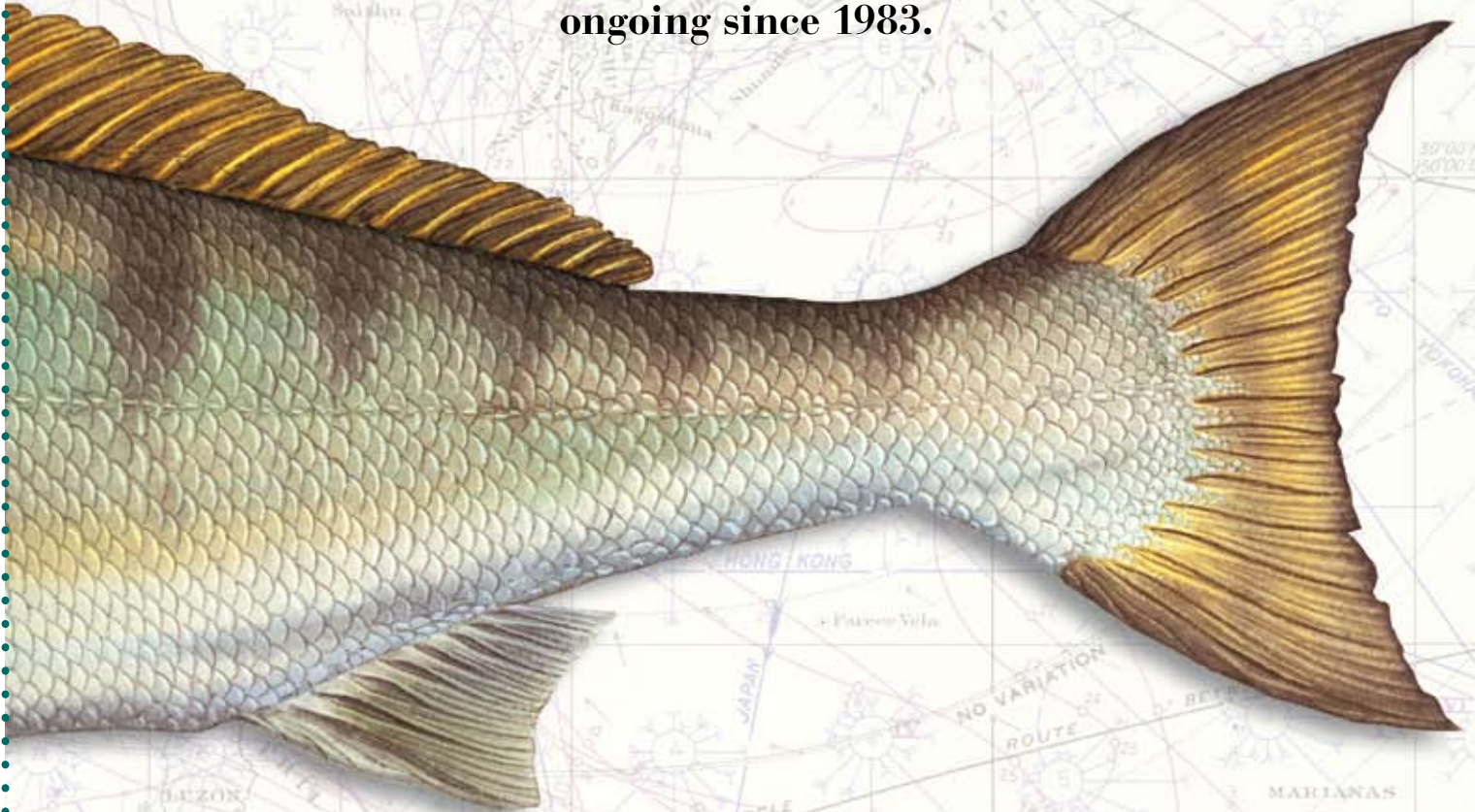
